SENATE PASSES MILITARY SALES BILL WITH COOPER-CHURCH AMENDMENT; OVERRIDES HOSPITAL CONSTRUCTION BILL VETO

176. HR 15628. Foreign Military Sales. Scott (R Pa.) motion to table Mansfield (D Mont.) motion to reconsider the vote by which the Griffin amendment was adopted. Rejected 46-47: R 31-11; D 15-36 (ND 5-29; SD 10-7), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the motion.

177. HR 15628. Mansfield motion to reconsider the vote by which the Griffin amendment was adopted. Agreed to 49-46: R 11-31; D 38-15 (ND 30-5; SD 8-10), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the motion.

178. HR 15628. Griffin amendment (*see vote no. 175*). Rejected 45-50: R 31-11; D 14-39 (ND 5-30; SD 9-9), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the amendment.

179. HR 15628. Jackson (D Wash.) amendment clarifying language in Cooper-Church amendment so as to prohibit further U.S. air activities in "direct" support of Cambodian forces. Adopted 69-27: R 33-9; D 36-18 (ND 21-15; SD 15-3), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the amendment.

180. HR 15628. Cooper (R Ky.)-Church (D Idaho) amendment barring funds for U.S. military operations in Cambodia after July 1, unless specifically authorized by Congress, including the retention of U.S. combat forces, advisers and air activities in direct support of Cambodian forces. Adopted 58-37: R 16-26; D 42-11 (ND 35-1; SD 7-10), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the amendment.

181. HR 15628. Passage of the bill authorizing \$250 million for the Foreign Military Sales program in each of fiscal years 1970 and 1971 and containing the Cooper-Church amendment. Passed 75-20: R 30-12; D 45-8 (ND 35-0; SD 10-8), June 30, 1970. The President did not take a position on the bill.

182. HR 11102. Hospital Construction. Reconsideration and passage of the bill, vetoed by the President June 22, extending the Hill-Burton program of construction and modernization of health facilities. Veto overridden 76-19: R 23-19; D 53-0 (ND 35-0; SD 18-0), June 30, 1970. A two-thirds majority (64 in this case) was required to override the veto. A "nay" was a vote supporting the President's position.

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
