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(U) Item 5: (57 pages, mimeographed; B-3) Propaganda pamphlet, written in Khmer, dated 30 Jan 71, originated from an unidentified agency ((possibly of the Red Khmer Southwestern Region in the Khmer Republic)), pertains to the appeal of Hu Yon, a member of the Politburo of the Central Committee of the National United Front of ((Red)) Khmer, concurrently Minister of Interior, Rural Reform, and Cooperative of the Coalition Government ((Sihanouk's exiled Government)), to scholars, and high school and university students living in areas temporarily controlled by the enemy ((Khmer Republic Government)). Hu Yon convinces the addressees not to trust Lon Nol, Sirik Matak, and Son Ngoc Thanh's efforts to establish a new constitution for the Khmer Republic. It is just a trick to distract the public opinion from their weaknesses, and to inveigle the people to their side. They are not men of democracy. Yon further urges the addressees to join the Front in order to liberate the Khmer people and to build a new Khmer Republic of independence, neutrality, peace, and democracy.
